What have we been up to this week?

Dosbarth Tysilio — This week in Dosbarth Tysilio, we explored what makes a real-life superhero and how these everyday heroes help and care for us. The children enjoyed a range of superhero-themed investigations, with Year 1 and 2 using their predicting skills to test ideas. In maths, Reception focused on matching objects to pictures and identifying sets of objects, while Year 1 and 2 practised counting forwards and backwards and created pictures using 2D shapes. For language and literacy, everyone designed their own superheroes and described them using imaginative words and phrases—showing fantastic creativity with their superpowers!

Dosbarth Tecla — Information provided by Fleur Daniels and Charlie Wicks-Driscoll of Year 5. On Monday in topic we looked at different Lego events from 1895 to present day. We then made a fact file on Ole Kirk Christian, the creator of Lego. We practised our Welsh words in gem loop. In PE we did different types of jumps. On Tuesday in maths we carried on with our topics from last week, reading and writing up to certain values. In language we wrote a passage on how we would persuade people to buy Lego sets. On Wednesday we looked at the different Lego logos over the years and put them on a timeline. We continued our Welsh work on gem loop. On Thursday in Welsh we wrote emotions and drew the emotion on Lego faces. We then made a graph of the classes favourite types of Lego sets. In the afternoon we made a poster on our persuasive writing. This morning we went to church and spoke about Christianity. We have then drawn a 3D Lego brick. After break we completed a spelling test, then this afternoon we are doing PE.
