What have we been up to this week?

Dosbarth Tysilio — This week in Dosbarth Tysilio we have enjoyed exploring the book *Superheroes ABC*, planning our own superhero pages using alliteration and practising capital letters for names. In Maths, Reception pupils have been exploring patterns while Year 1 and 2 have focused on finding numbers that are one more and one less. As part of our topic work, we began studying the pop art of Roy Lichtenstein and created our own colourful artwork using primary colours. We also prepared a healthy superhero meal using our knowledge of the Eatwell Plate, and in Welsh we started learning the names of people who help us as well as practising the songs for our Jamboree.

We had to decide on their name, age, hobbies and special skills. In Welsh we worked on the iPad pairing the start and end of sentences together. On Tuesday we were learning about area and perimeter.
